Easter Offering – a background to why this happens and where the money is used.

Each year the Methodist Church holds an Easter Offering dedication service. The tradition dates back to 1883, when women in Manchester collected £32 for missionary work overseas. In March 1884 the London Districts distributed Easter Envelopes and asked for a penny a head and collected around £100. Since then, each successive Methodist Women's movement has encouraged donations in support of God's mission. The appeal is now run by Methodist Women in Britain. Easter Envelopes for your gift will be available from 8 th March and can be filled and returned via the collection box. All the money from our church will be presented at an afternoon Circuit Service in Dorchester on 19 th April. Funds raised go to the World Mission Fund for work with Partner Churches throughout the world. In 2024 collections from the Easter Offering raised over £200,000. Perhaps please consider your giving as part of your Lent preparations for Easter.
